Encourage students to report incidents of ragging without fear.

Establish an atmosphere of mutual respect, discipline, friendship, and cooperation between senior and junior students.

Ensure prompt and appropriate action against any reported case of ragging.

Regularly monitor the campus, hostels, classrooms, common areas, and other vulnerable locations to prevent ragging.

3. Objectives

- To prevent ragging in all forms within the institution.
- To educate students about what constitutes ragging and its legal/disciplinary consequences.
- To ensure effective implementation of anti-ragging rules and regulations.
- To conduct awareness programmes, orientations, counselling sessions, and anti-ragging activities.
- To provide a safe mechanism for students to report complaints.
- To maintain confidentiality while dealing with complaints, wherever appropriate.
- To coordinate with the Anti-Ragging Squad for regular monitoring and preventive action.
- To take disciplinary action against students found involved in ragging as per applicable rules.
- To maintain proper records of awareness programmes, inspections, complaints, and actions taken.
- To promote a healthy and harmonious relationship between students of different batches.
